

To make the review process easier, please check the following topics before submitting the manuscript:

1. Is the study relevant, containing sufficient original data and is it novel in the area of research?
2. Is the title of the manuscript concise, accurate, informative and corresponding to its content?
3. Is the text structure logical, and does it correspond to that of articles recently published in the journal?
4. Are the relevance of the study and the present state of knowledge of the topic supported by appropriate references?
5. Are the methods correct for solving the problem of the study?
6. Is the description of Material and Methods correct, sufficient and not superfluous?
7. Are little-known terms, if present, clarified in the text?
8. Are the results of the study complete and clearly presented?
9. Are there references to the specimens and the allocation of the herbarium collections (if necessary)?
10. Do tables, if present, augment the text, and are their contents discussed?
11. Is the analysis of the results adequate and pertinent from a methodological point of view?
12. Are all illustrations and tables necessary and meaningful for the paper?
13. Do all illustrations and tables have clear titles, legends and annotations?
14. Are all author's/authors' opinions in the text well-grounded by data presented and/or supported by necessary references?
15. Are all conclusions clear and robust?
16. Are references in the text sufficient and present in the list of references and *vice versa*?
17. Are nomenclature conclusions correct and corresponding to the latest edition of the [International Code of Nomenclature for algae, fungi, and plants](#)?
18. Is the text of the manuscript linguistically correct and easily understandable?
19. Are all recommendations for manuscript preparation fulfilled according to the Instructions for Authors?
