

**To make the review process easier check the following points before submitting the manuscript:**

- 1) Is the study relevant, containing sufficient original data and is novel in the area of research?
- 2) Are the topics clearly stated in the Abstract, Résumé in Russian and Introduction?
- 3) Does title of the manuscript correspond to its content?
- 4) Are the Abstract and Résumé in Russian concise and complete? Do they reflect all stages, results and conclusions of the work?
- 5) Do Keywords correspond to the content of manuscript and are they in alphabetical order?
- 6) Is the order of the parts of the manuscript correct and corresponding to paragraph 8.4.6. of Instructions for Authors
- 7) Is the structure of the text logical and corresponding to paragraph 8.3. of Instruction for Authors.
- 8) Are the relevance of the study and the present state of knowledge of the topic outlined in the Introduction and supported by appropriate references?
- 9) Are the methods correct for solving the problem of the study?
- 10) Is the description of Material and Methods correct, sufficient and not superfluous?
- 11) Are little-known terms (if present) clearly explained in the text?
- 12) Are the results of the study completely and clearly presented?
- 13) Are there references in the manuscript to specimens and the allocation of the herbarium collections (if it is necessary)?
- 14) If tables are present, they should augment the text. There should be no repetition of table content in the text.
- 15) Is analysis of the results adequate and pertinent from a methodological point of view?
- 16) Are all illustrations and tables necessary and meaningful for the paper?
- 17) Do all illustrations and tables have clear titles, legends, and annotations?
- 18) Are all author's/authors' opinions in the text well-grounded by data presented and/or supported by necessary references?
- 19) Are all conclusions clear and sound?
- 20) Are references in the text sufficient and present in the list of references?
- 21) Are nomenclature conclusions correct and corresponding to the latest edition of the International Code of Nomenclature for algae, fungi, and plants?
- 22) Is the text of the manuscript linguistically correct and easily understandable?
- 23) Are all recommendations for preparation of manuscripts fulfilled according to the Instructions for Authors?
